Tip of the Day: How to Share *This Visit* Diagnoses and Create Handover Notes and Discharge Summaries

Main Points:

- The Most Responsible Physician (MRP) refines *This Visit* problems so they effectively can provide daily care and hand-over documentation.
- *This Visit* problems that are fully treated in the hospital stay can be stored in the Hospital Course component until needed for the transfer of care documentation (See creating Handover Notes or Discharge Summaries below).

Share *This Visit* Diagnoses:

The *This Visit* diagnoses can be used to shorten the time and effort it takes to complete clinical documentation. **Since the list is shared among many providers, we need to agree how to share the *This Visit* list, or its benefits will be lost.** Here are some guidelines.



During an acute care encounter, the most responsible physician (MRP) will likely manage most of the *This Visit* problems as well as construct a handover note or discharge summary. The problem list belongs to the patient and not to the MRP. However, the MRP would be expected to reconcile and maintain the list on a regular basis to reflect the current status and to keep the list manageable for all providers involved in the care of the patient.

Please do not delete *This Visit* problems that are being used by other providers involved in the patient's care. Reviewing documentation by other providers will clarify which are active or inactive.

Creating Handover Notes or Discharge Summaries

If you remove a *This Visit* diagnosis, please consider documenting the diagnosis and resolution in the Hospital Course component for future reference. This can be applied to their discharge summary or a handover note.
