Individual Observation Record & Patient Status Rounding

Patients who are at risk of harming themselves or others (indicated by a moderate or high VBACT score) require the implementation of close and constant care as per [Island Health Guideline 24.1.5G](#).

Close and Constant Care is an organizational requirement that helps manage violent or unsafe behaviors to maintain safety of our patients and our staff. Use the [Decision Support Tool](#) to assist you in understanding when and how to implement Close and Constant Care

Important Points:

- Close and constant (1:1) care observation can be documented in **Individual Observation Record** and general status and sleep/ rest can be documented in **Patient Status Rounding** in Interactive View and I&O.

Individual Observation Record

Located in Interactive View in the Quick View band (may need to be customized on view)

Used to document close and constant observation of a patient to indicate patient location, patient activity and any observations comments

Information entered here will flow to the safety and attendance tool (used by MHSU and HCA) and will display in results review
